

## 1.1 Dedicated Sport Handgun practical test Target size (A4)



**Handgun or revolver:** calibers from .22 rimfire.

**Target:** Dedicated Rifle Target

### Course of Fire

This event is shot at 10 meters

It takes approximately 5 minutes to complete

It requires 5 rounds. The maximum possible score is 25

**Position:** Standing unsupported

**Ready Position:** Revolver holstered, hammer down. Pistol holstered, slide forward, safety catch applied

**Sights:** Any colour iron (spotting scopes may be used)

**Eye & Ear Protection** – The wearing of eye and ear protection is required at all times.

### Scoring

Targets are to be scored in the usual manner: i.e. a hit that touches a scoring ring shall be given the higher value if a gauge of the same caliber as that used to fire on the target, touches some part of the ring when the gauge is inserted in the bullet hole, or an overlay scoring slide of the same caliber as that used to fire on the target touches some part of the scoring ring when the slide is laid on the target. A round that is found to have "tumbled" will be scored in the usual manner (best edge) if any part of the shot touches the scoring ring then it will be given that value. A tumbled round cannot be gauged.
